Judging Criteria, Scoring System and Awards for Educational Displays

Gun Show displays are judged and awarded prizes based on the following criteria and scoring system:

1.	Educational Factors:	
a.	Title – is there a title for the display?	5
b.	Contents – How well does the display fit the title?	10
c.	Labeling	
1.	Is the title adequately explained or amplified?	10
2.	Are individual specimens properly and adequately identified?	15
3.	Related Items – Do catalogs, accoutrements, etc. enhance the display?	10
II.	Material of the Display (guns and other items)	
a.	Completeness – Material displayed relative to the title?	10
b.	Condition – How well does the condition compare to material available?	10
c.	Rarity of items displayed	10
d.	Collectors importance of items displayed	5
III.	General Appeal – Neatness, general appearance, relative skill and creativity evidenced in the display and public interest?	15
